(ii) Why did Henchard decide to punish Abel Whittle ? Who stopped him from carrying out the punishment ?

(C) Make a Precis of the following passage and give a suitable title :

It is not an exaggeration to say that the high level proficiency of Indians in using the English language and their dexterity with technology have lent a great deal to the economic development of the nation. Having more than 300 years of contact with the language, Indians are much better placed internationally in terms of Competence to use English vis-a-vis most other Asians, especially the Japanese, the Chinese and the Koreans. This is one reason why Indians have received numerous international projects in the fields of translation from and into English, not only of literary works but also of technical and scientific research work. Proliferation of the BPO industry in India is evidence enough in this regard. In terms of quantity, publications in India are the highest in English, and in terms of quality, Indian writers have proved their acumen in the international arena.
